


Meaningful Lists Exceptions to the rule..

I'm reporting content that needs to be changed
I'm reporting content that needs to be removed
I'm reporting content that needs to be added
I have an idea for improving our Web site

Active Voice The use of active voice should be done by you...

Bad

The submission of the information that I have requested will be due at the stroke of noon tomorrow

Best

Please submit the requested information promptly by noon, tomorrow.

Brevity Eliminate unnecessary words...

Bad

Now imagine you were to happen upon a page dense with myriad links, all of which read 'click here'. Such a dense page would not lend itself to scanning.

Best

A page littered with 'click here' links would not lend itself to efficient scanning.

Numbers v. Words Numerals scan much better than words...

Bad

The library reserves 12 group study rooms (two to six occupants) and ten large group study rooms (two to 12 occupants) for student use.

Better

The library reserves **12 group study rooms** (2-6 occupants) and **10 large group study rooms** (2-12 occupants) for student use.

Images Images should be meaningful to page content...



Visual Consistency Create a style guide to guarantee visual consistency...

For more complicated examples, list additional titles in order of importance. Append Mobile, then Fax number below land-line telephones, if appropriate. Delineate phone numbers with the prefixes Tel, Mob, and Fax, without colons.






